FEL Motorsports Academy

WHAT IS IT?

FEL Motorsports Academy is a 3-day accelerated driving school for drivers looking to get a CASC approved race licence. Coaches from Brack Driving Concepts will deliver three driver training programs over the duration of the weekend;

Racer Development

Geared to drivers with no or limited experience in high-performance driving, this course features a coaching with a mix of classroom theory, on-track practice and skid pad exercises with one of our in-car coaches.

Racer Observations

Designed for drivers who intend on applying for their regional race license. The training includes a combination of "race exercises" and in-car observation by one of our senior coaches.

Race Procedures

This classroom-based training focuses on the rules and regulations governing racing and practical "how to" information in preparation for your first race weekend. The day concludes with a written exam with a 75% pass requirement.

WHAT ELSE WILL I REQUIRE TO GET LICENSED?

Upon successful completion, you will be provided with a certificate of completion. This certificate will entitle you to apply for a race license with your regional race organization (e.g. CASC-OR).

 To receive a full Road Race Licence, you will require a number of items and/or documents to be completed prior to granting your license which will include the following: their form completed, our certificate, a race medical on the appropriate form, evidence of membership in one of a number of affiliated clubs, a passport-size photo, and the race license fee.







WHO IS THE FEL MOTORSPORTS ACADEMY FOR?

The FEL Motorsports Academy is geared to drivers with no to limited experience in high-performance driving looking to start racing in 2022 or 2023.

WHERE IS IT LOCATED?

Canadian Tire Motorsport Park's Driver Development Track

WHEN IS IT?

- Registration: 8:30am Daily
- Course: 9am 5pm Daily
- Friday, April 1
- In class with written exam and skid pad training only, no track time.
- F Saturday, April 2 and Sunday, April 3
- In car training with your personal coach over 30-minute rotating sessions between FEL Motorsports Test & Tune participants

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

- **\$1,995.00 + HST**
- This cost includes the fee for the accelerated 1:1 licensing program, track time, daily lunch, as well as input from FEL Motorsports Sporting Directors and Canadian Motorsports Hall of Famers; Robin Buck and Peter Lockhart.







WHAT WILL I NEED TO BRING WITH ME?

Frimarily - your own street car. You will be using your street car to complete the training. Your vehicle must have equal seating and restraints for passenger and driver. Once you have registered for the FEL Motorsports Academy, you will receive an email containing all important information and other items to bring with you from the coaches at Brack Driving Concepts.

WILL I BE ABLE TO RACE WITH FEL MOTORSPORTS IN 2022?

Provided that you successfully complete the program and receive your sanctioned racing licence, you will be required to race in a minimum of one regional race in the presence of an observer who will decide whether you can race professionally with FEL Motorsports.
